



Five Reasons to Go to Mexico

Soak Up the Sun on Mexico's Diverse Beaches

Mexico is surrounded by more than 400 beaches, many with their own distinct personalities. A good place to start is at the Sea of Cortez, which Jacques Cousteau once called "The Aquarium of the World" because nearly 40 percent of the world's marine mammals live there. Boat excursions like Los Cabos' travelers out in the water on scavenger hunts to spot sea lions, whales and dolphins. Guests at resorts like Grand Velas' Land's End Resort and Spa spot can spot migrating whales. In Cozumel, scuba divers explore great reefs with colorful, tropical fish darting about alongside turtles and seahorses. At the Occidental Cozumel, set in a mangrove and perched on the beach, instructors guide new scuba divers, and in Mazatlán, tourists are amazed by the cliff jumpers who gracefully dive from El Clavadista for tips. At nearby Puerto Vallarta, Playa del Amor – also called Hidden Beach – is certainly photo-worthy, as it's surrounded by caverns with a circular hole above that lets the sunshine beam through.

"We're seeing something very solid [with Cancún], especially," said Cole. "A lot of them have been open two years or five years, ready to go to business or bridge markets. Now, an increasing number of luxury tourists are staying somewhere else for a week to do all their touring. They're going to see the hotel and see the beach, but they're not staying there." One reason is that the tourism there may be slow off the archaeological sites and other destinations.

He added, "I made a presentation to agents at *Attica* recently. They told me they didn't see anything there, just beach destinations."

Another option growing in popularity could be in a cooking school or some form of cultural group. The *Marina Las Brisas* cooking school has *Puerto Morelos*, each of Cancún or one over great choices. The *Baja California* also has cooking school. You can call and make a reservation. Despite Violence, Tourism Is Strong in Mexican Resort Areas

Tourists continue to flock to Cancún and the Riviera Maya, where authorities have promoted initiatives to increase security.

Travelers continue to flock to Cancún and the adjacent Riviera Maya in Mexico. Cancún means an endless beach escape with something for everyone from thrill-seeking divers to sunbathers. The Riviera Maya, with its coral reefs, jungle, ancient Mayan ruins, and more, offers travel in the opposite direction, focusing on the history.

The local archeological site Chichen Itza experienced 14 murders in Cancún over a 30-hour period in early April, continuing a pattern of violence reported last month, according to the state attorney general. Tulum, the adjacent town on the Riviera Maya, about 50 miles south of Cancún,

travelers have not been targeted in those crimes, but a family that descended in February on a tony hiking trail did confront with the island of Cozumel, a popular tourist park, reported police statistics. Police responded by closing the trail, which has been closed since the state to issue a travel ban on the ferry route for government employees. Tulum, however, reported the hotel was a temporary closure followed by an order to evacuate or re-opened earlier.

Still, state, Mexican authorities have strengthened security around the


